

Location: The camp is located at the Sports Complex, on the campus of the College of Mount St. Joseph. If camp numbers exceed the capacity that the stadium can hold some sessions will be ran at the River Road Practice Facility.

Registration: Registration will take place on July 12th, 2010. It will open 1 hour before the start of the camp. For the remaining days, camp doors will open 30 minutes prior to the start of camp. Parents are welcome to watch from the stands. Please arrange for prompt pick up at the conclusion of each day.

Confirmation: A confirmation email will be sent on or around July 5th, 2010 for those who have registered and paid prior to then.

Insurance: Each camper must have his/her own medical insurance. The Mount Soccer Camp will not be responsible for any medical or dental insurance. A medical release form is included and must be signed by a parent or guardian. The health and protection of all campers will be our first and foremost concern. A certified athletic trainer will be available daily.

Costs: Completed applications must be received by July 5, 2010 in order to ensure proper staffing.

The Lion's coach played for the Cincinnati Ladyhawks for 5 years as well as a short stint with the Atlanta Beat of the former WUSA. Todd has coached at numerous local soccer camps as well as coaching the STAR soccer U16 girls team.

Coach Todd is also a Licensed and Certified Athletic Trainer. She graduated from The Mount with a Bachelors of Science in Athletic Training in 2008.



Rudy Argueta returns to The Mount in the fall of 2010 for his second season as head coach for the men's program. In his first season at the helm he managed to change the outlook of the program and build a strong foundation for the future. Argueta is returning as the women's assistant for his fourth season.

He is a 2002 graduate of NAIA Union College in Barbourville, Ky., where he was a four-year starter. While at Union, he was the first player in school history to score 40 goals and have 40 assists. He was a 3 year First Team All-Conference selection, a two-time team captain, team MVP, and All-Region and All-American Honorable Mention. In addition, he was the 1998 Rookie of the Year and 2001 Mid-South Conference Player of the Year. Argueta graduated with a triple major, business administration, sports management and physical education, and a minor in economics.

Argueta, a midfielder, has professional soccer experience with the Columbus Crew and InfoSport. Furthermore, he played with two different teams in the Professional Development League and the U12 Guatemalan National Team from 1989-1991. He currently works numerous local soccer camps and trains the Kings Soccer Academy U17 girls team.

It is understood that the said Camp does not take responsibility for the physical fitness of camp attendees and that as parents and/or guardians we take full responsibility for the physical condition of our minor child.
- 6) I/we further certify we have health and hospitalization insurance under which said child is insured. I/we further grant the Camp Directors to have my child treated by a physician in the event of an emergency and I/We cannot be immediately contacted.
